The public is invited to view the video and the historical photo album which accompanies it.

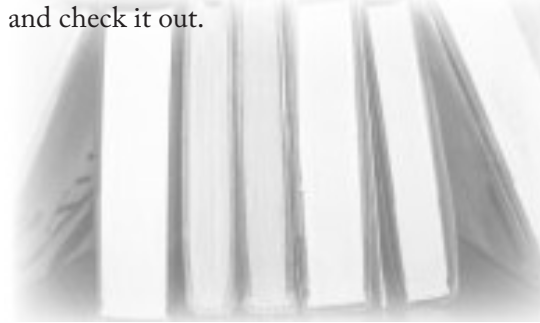

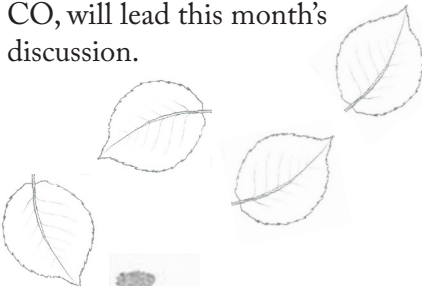

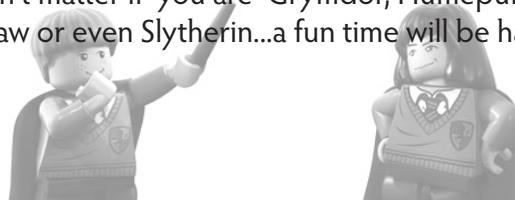
Wizards Day Party
