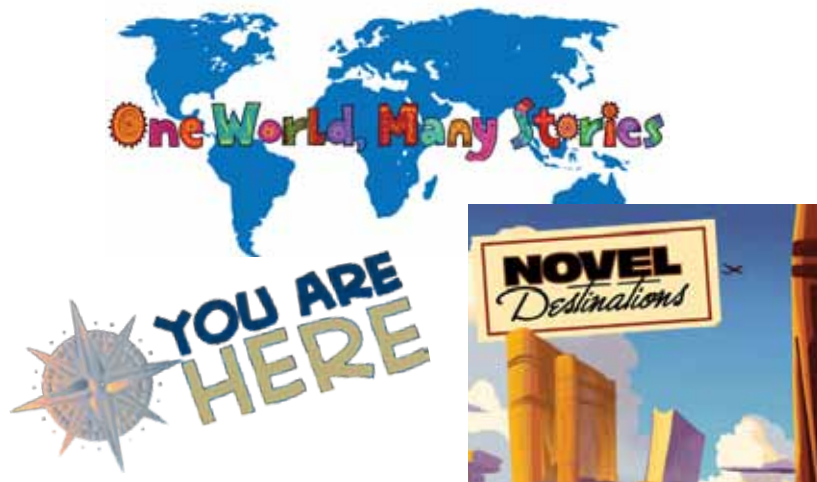

The 2011 Summer Reading Programs

Many Worlds, One Story (Kids 0-12)

Teens read up to 15 hours in 15 minute increments for prizes at the 5 hour, 10 hour, and 15 hour levels. Teens that complete 15 hours of reading will be entered into a drawing for a book gift certificate package.

Novel Destinations (Adults 18+)

Adults do six reading-related activities to receive a prize and be entered into a drawing for Wreck This Journal by Keri Smith and a travel mug.
