

## Stay in the Loop

Email notification is a great way to learn what fiction books, movies, audiobooks, or music cds have been added to the library system in the last month - and you never have to leave home!

Are you a fiction reader who tracks the New York Best Sellers list or can't wait for the next book in that science fiction series? Then sign up for our 'fiction' email notification list. When the latest book by your favorite author appears in the email, you can place a hold on the book without leaving your home. Just go to our web page - carbonlibraries.org click on card catalog, find the book you are interested in, and place a hold. Library staff will call you when the book is available.

The Carbon County Library System receives many music cds each month. You could listen to the hottest artists for free by checking out the albums from the library. Email notifications lets you know what new music is in the collection waiting to be listened to.

Where you are a music, movie, audiobook, or fiction fan, we can help you keep up to date with the newest additions to the library collection. Sign up for email notification today by going to carbonlibraries.org and clicking on email notification in the right hand panel.
