## Ebooks coming to our Libraries

The Wyoming State Library should have a new downloadable eBook platform up and running soon thanks to a contract with 3M. This Cloud Library, as it is called, allows libraries to purchase titles and offer them to check out electronically to their patrons. Every library in the statewide WYLDcat system in Wyoming will have access to a shared Web site.

Right now 3M works with most eReaders, except for the Kindle. But 3M is working with Amazon to try to expand the offering. If you have a Nook, one of Sony's eReaders, or even a 3M model, you'll be all set to download these books.

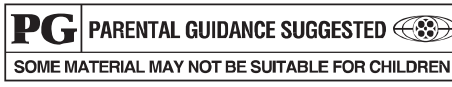
