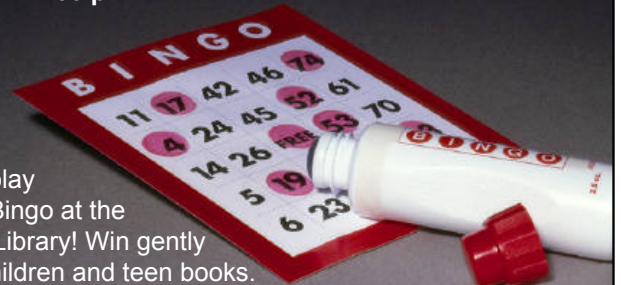
Let's stop the insanity!

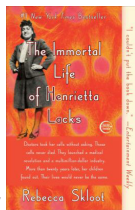

- Suggested household income of \$50,000 or less

- W2 Forms
- Social Security cards (or documentation with Social Security numbers) and birth dates for all household members
- Other relevant tax forms including 1099s and 1098s
- Copy of 2011 returns, if possible
