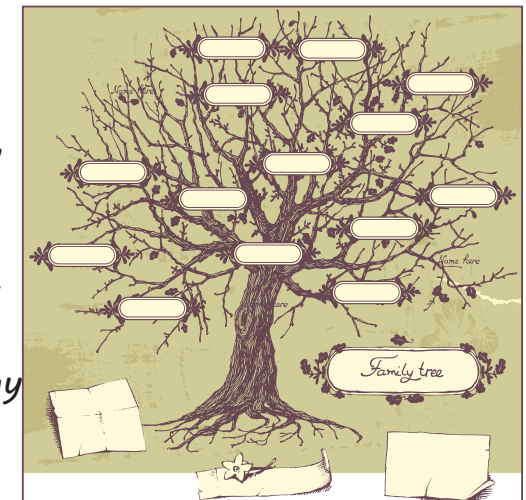
## Basic Intro to Genealogy Workshop
